2012 STALLION BREEDING CONTRACT

CONTRACT NUMBER: 2012-_____

This contract is for the breeding by artificial insemination, the stallion, _____, to the mare listed below. The fee for this service is **\$2,500.00**. \$1,250.00 deposit is due at the signing of this contract and the balance is due 60 days after the mare is confirmed in foal. **Semen collection fees are in addition to the breeding service fee shown above and must be prepaid to Dr. Juan Pablo Toro, Equine Veterinary Concepts, 352-653-9230, in amount of \$150.00 for local Ocala pickup or \$380.00 for shipped semen.** Semen will not be provided without prepaid collection fees, or without signed contract and a deposit of \$1,250.00 paid (American Express, MasterCard, Visa and Discover credit cards accepted).

Payment: A 50% deposit of \$1,250.00 is due at the signing of this contract and, at minimum, 24 hours prior to requesting semen. The balance of \$1,250.00 is due 60 days after the mare is confirmed in foal.

Registration applications will not be signed for any foal resulting from a breeding if there is an outstanding balance due for stud fee; or for boarding if mare was boarded at Besilu Collection for breeding; or for semen collection fees due to Equine Veterinary Concepts.

The Stallion Owner agrees:

1. To provide DNA verification and registration of the stallion in accordance with PFHA / other breed registry rules.
2. To provide all required documentation for the registration of the resulting offspring, with exception if fees are due per Payment paragraph above.
3. To guarantee that all resulting foals from this breeding will pass the stallion side of the parental verification test.
4. To guarantee a live foal. A live foal is defined as a foal that stands and nurses and survives for at least twenty four hours.
5. To provide semen shipment for use in a timely manner.
6. That should the stallion die or become unfit for service before the first shipment of semen for the contracted mare, this contract shall be null and void and the deposit paid will be refunded to mare owner.

The Mare Owner/Agent agrees:

1. To present the mare in good health and in clean and sound breeding condition and checked by a licensed veterinarian to insure that so that the mare's heat cycle may be anticipated, and to advise stallion owner of probable ovulation date in time for 18 hours notice for semen collection and transport.
2. To prepay \$150.00 for each local Ocala semen collection or \$380.00 for each shipped semen collection to Equine Veterinary Concepts, Dr. Juan Pablo Toro. **Collection charges must be paid in full before semen is shipped.**
3. To return any blue shipping container within forty-eight hours of use to Equine Veterinary Concepts and to insure shipping container for its full replacement cost or be responsible for full replacement cost if not insured.
4. If requested, to provide a negative culture test and/or any other test (at mare owner's expense) to verify the breeding condition of the mare.
5. To artificially inseminate mare for at least three (3) successive heat cycles. If however, after three (3) successive heat cycles, said mare cannot be certified in foal by a licensed veterinarian; the stallion owner shall reserve the right to withdraw from its agreement and shall be granted release from further obligation and shall refund stud fee deposit paid to mare owner.
6. To notify Besilu Collection when mare is confirmed in foal and to pay balance due of stud fee (\$1,250.00) within 60 days of this date. To notify Besilu Collection if the mare fails to conceive a foal, or if foal is aborted during the pregnancy.
7. In the event that no live foal is born or if mare aborts the foal, mare owner may request a full refund of the stud fee paid by providing an official veterinary certification stating such and submitting a formal written request to Besilu Collection. In this event, this contract is terminated.

Risk of Loss. The mare owner assumes all responsibility for the condition of the mare and shall bear all risk of loss or damage to the mare whether by death, disease, injury, infection or otherwise, and by any cause whatsoever, and therefore holds harmless the BESILU COLLECTION, INC., a Florida Corporation or any person employed by, or associated with the BESILU COLLECTION, INC., a Florida Corporation.

Breach. In the event of a breach of contract, the mare owner is responsible for all costs, charges, expenses and disbursements of a the stallion owner/agent, including all attorneys' fees incurred in securing payment of such breeding(s), or any part of the same, or in any proceeding action concerning same or looking toward the protection for the stallion owner/agent rights or collection of the monies owed or any part thereof.

Assignment. This Contract nor the Stallion Service may be assigned by Buyer without written consent of the Seller.

Venue. The venue for any legal action to enforce the terms of this contract shall lie in Marion County, Florida.
